



Cresap Family Foundation Announces 2017 Nonprofit Grants

Oklahoma City- The Cresap Family Foundation is proud to announce grant distribution totaling over \$1.0 million dollars to support 70 nonprofit organizations across Oklahoma.

As evidenced in the list of grants awarded below, the Cresap Family Foundation focused on providing much needed funds to organizations that provide basic needs- like, food, shelter and human services.

“We know and understand that nonprofit organizations across our state are suffering from federal and state funding cuts,” said John Cresap, President, Cresap Family Foundation. “This year, we focused on providing funds to fill the gap and ensure Oklahomans in all our areas of interest have their basic needs met.”

Denny, Gail and John Cresap established the foundation following the sale of the family’s business, Premium Beers of Oklahoma, one of the largest Anheuser-Busch distributorships in the country. A desire to give back to the communities that had supported Premium Beers of Oklahoma for 44 years resulted in the foundation’s creation. Including its 2017 grant-making activities, the Cresap Family Foundation has given more than \$4.4 million to Oklahoma nonprofits since its founding in 2012.
